MEALS

Wilderness Adventures' meals require compromise, flexibility, and a positive attitude:

- We typically eat six times a day: breakfast, morning snack, lunch, an afternoon snack, dinner, and dessert.
- All members of the group share all meals and snacks together.

 For most meals, leaders and students decide on meals and snacks for the group as part of a cook crew. Some meals will be provided by outside companies or at a restaurant. Everyone has to be flexible at meal and snack times to accommodate the group. If you are a vegetarian, please keep in mind that vegetarian meals are often prepared by withholding the meat portion of whatever the group is having (for example, tacos with the meat on the side). We cannot always accommodate severe vegan, kosher, gluten-free diets, or other eating allergies. Please call the office to determine what accommodations can be made.

POTENTIAL GROUNDS FOR DISMISSAL Wilderness Adventures' Trip Expectations & Rules include, but are not limited to, the following and may be cause for early dismissal from the program:
 Unsafe behavior, which includes but is not limited to: failure to wear seat belts, life jackets, and other safety equipment. Body piercing, tattoos or any other form of self-mutilation done on the trip. Possession or use of weapons of any kind. Unpermitted travel alone, away from the group. Shoplifting, destruction of property, or any other illegal acts. Behavior that is destructive, dangerous, abusive, violent, injurious to themselves and/or others or involves harassment, vandalism or repeated violation of rules and expectations. Exclusive relationships, sexual activity, unauthorized absence from the group, or failure to abide by curfews and/or other expectations of behavior.
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SUBSTANCE USE Wilderness Adventures prohibits the recreational use and/or distribution of prescription, nonprescription or other drugs, tobacco and alcohol.
