ALASKA HIGH TRAILS RENTAL GEAR

REQUIRED RENTAL GEAR

A pair of rubberized rain gear (bibs and jacket) and a pair of rubber boots are required for sea kayaking on Prince William Sound and must be rented from the kayak center. These items will only be used for the time you are kayaking. The cost to rent is as follows:

Rubberized Rain Gear: \$30

Rubber Boots: \$15

Please factor this cost into the amount of spending money you bring. Each student will need to rent these items at the start of the kayaking section. These rentals are in addition to the items listed on the packing list.
